


# Population Statistics 2022



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## About This Report

The population data shown in this report is based on records of residents actively registered with Manitoba Health as of June 1, 2022 and published by Manitoba Health and Seniors Care (<https://www.gov.mb.ca/health/population/>). This population database is considered a reliable and accurate estimate of population sizes, and is helpful for understanding trends and useful for health planning purposes.


### Label Change to Population Report







## 10 Year Population Growth (2012-2022)

As shown below, the 2022 population for the Southern Health-Santé Sud was **222,369** with an annual growth rate of 2.9%, and a ten-year growth rate of 21.4%. This translates to 6,216 more residents in the past year (2021 to 2022) and to 39,143 more residents in the past ten years (2012 to 2022).



## Manitoba RHA Comparisons

Southern Health-Santé Sud continues to have the fastest growing population in Manitoba. It has grown by 21% in the past decade which is the highest in the province. The Manitoba average growth rate for this time period was 12%.

As shown below, Manitoba has grown over 156,500 residents over the past decade. Winnipeg, during this time period, represented over 90,500 new residents and contributed to 57.8% of the Manitoba growth. Nevertheless, Southern Health-Santé Sud's contribution of 24.9%, was the largest volume growth among rural RHAs. This population growth pattern for regions across Manitoba has been fairly consistent over the years.



### Age Group Comparisons

Southern Health-Santé Sud's population continues to grow across almost all age groups. In particular, it is worth noting that while Manitoba has only grown by 11% in the youngest age group (0-14 years), the region has grown by 22% in the youngest age group (0-14 years). The graph also depicts an aging population with the fastest growing cohort between 65-74 years ("baby boomers").

### Population Change by Age Group, Manitoba and Southern Health-Santé Sud, 2012-2022.



## District and Municipal Population Change

The figure below shows the population growth within the region by districts. The district of Cartier-SFX experienced the highest rate of growth at 53%. The districts which experienced a lot of population change (25 percent or more), included: Cartier-SFX, Niverville-Ritchot, Macdonald, Stanley, Morden city, Winkler city, Ste Anne-LaBroquerie and Hanover. In contrast, the districts which experienced very little population change (5 percent or less) included: Grey and Red River South.



