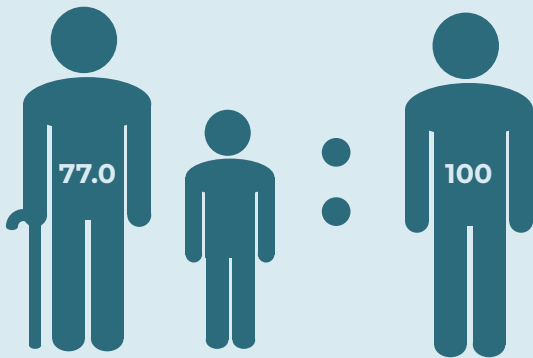

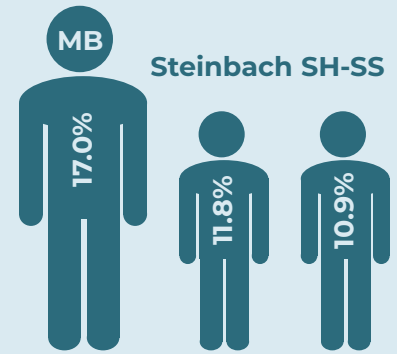

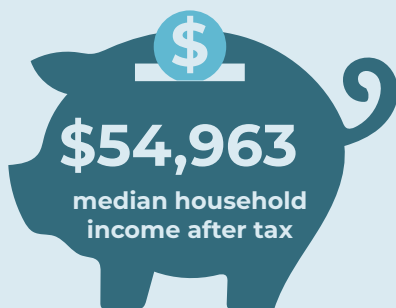

DEPENDENCY RATIO

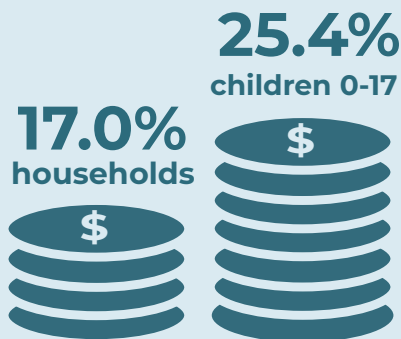
Ratio of youth (0-19) & older adult (65+) dependents to working age population (20-64) reflecting pressure on the working population to care for dependents

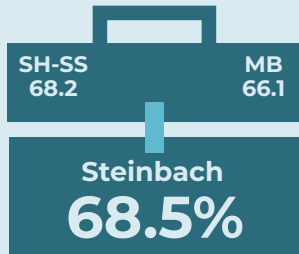

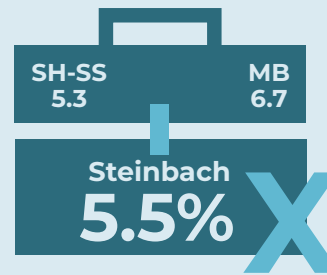

LABOUR FORCE

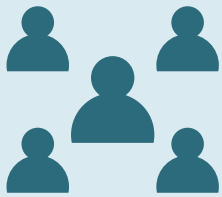


aged 15+ participate in labour force, more males vs. females

reflects status of family, workplace, & community relationships

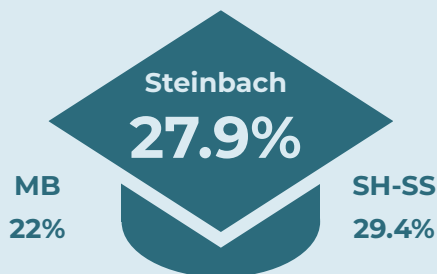


MATERIAL DEPRIVATION

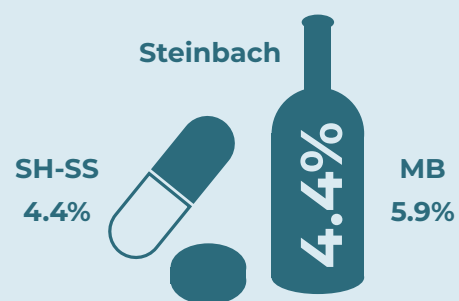

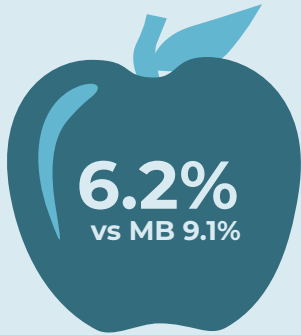

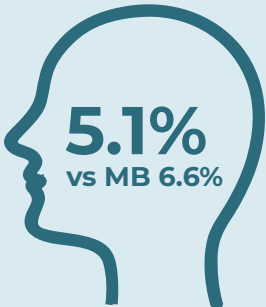


disorders lower vs. MB

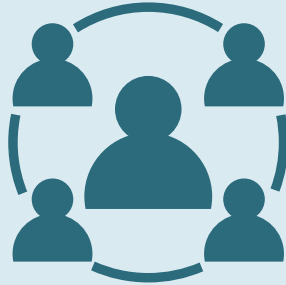

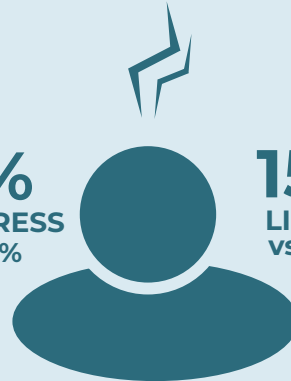
